The 15th Century Castle Ruin

Situated on an ancient hill with breathtaking views of Oban Bay and the Inner Hebridean Isles.

The Leafy Green Willow Garden and Raven Knoll

A secluded garden area with a Willow Tipi, Domed Gazebo and Boardwalk, and Raven Knoll with wooden sculptures.

The Marquee Meadow

Bring your own marquee and pop it in our 80x25 metre wildflower meadow, which has spectacular coastal woodland views.

The World of Trees Wooden Gazebo

Our purpose built wooden Gazebo surrounded by ancient trees, adjacent to our Marquee Meadow.

The 1745 House Museum Terrace

After your ceremony, you and your guests will be welcomed to the 1745 Dunollie House terrace. Our Oak-framed, Heated Gazebo seats up to 50 people.

Dunollie is an ancient heritage site and museum in Oban, Argyll and historic seat of Clan MacDougall. The Castle, Museum, Draper's Shop and Kettle Cafe are managed by a dedicated team and expert front of house staff. Without the help of local volunteers, who do anything from gardening to helping us look after our historic collections, Dunollie wouldn't be the amazing place it is today. We work closely with our local community, run a health and wellbeing group, and host activities for children and high-school students in the local area via our Dunollie Links programme. Besides being closely connected with our local community, we strive to run our Charity as sustainably as possible. We collaborate with local makers, artists and food producers, grow our own flowers, veg, herbs, and honey, don't use single-use plastics, and reuse, repurpose, and recycle as much as possible. We have hosted a few exclusive weddings over the years, and are now delighted to be able to offer our all-inclusive wedding packages for 2025 and beyond.
